And 10 percent of online sales of [Lail Vineyards](#) Blueprint label benefit Cool Effect, an organization backing carbon-reducing projects around the globe. The 2017 Blueprint Cabernet opens with red currant, plum, anise, cedar, and sweet pipe tobacco. Lush mixed berry flavors follow, bright and creamy, wrapped in chalky tannins. **(\$80)**



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
