"2019 was a fabulous vintage in Napa Valley, producing excellent wines full of character and pizzazz. The long and moderate growing season allowed for the flavors to develop slowly and precisely. Deep garnet with purple edges, Welly Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 has enticing aromas of ripe plum, blackberry puree, anise, forest floor and toasted coconut. Flavors pile on, adding briary black raspberry, olallieberry, boysenberry, and fresh cedar. There are fine and creamy tannins that lay forth a silky, seamless, luxurious and rich finish.
