

“Sourced from 11 different sites in the Napa Valley, Lail’s 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon Blueprint is a fine value, sometimes available locally (in Napa) at a discount to the quoted suggested retail price. Sophisticated aromas of crushed stone and dried herbs accent mixed red and black cherries on the nose, plus there’s an appealing, savory hint of dusty earth. Medium to full-bodied, the wine exhibits a silky feel and mouthwatering acids on the palate. Drink this easy-drinking vintage over the next decade or so.”

“The 2022 Blueprint Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of 97% Cabernet Sauvignon and 3% Petit Verdot. Deep garnet-purple colored, it comes tearing out with gregarious notes of blackcurrant jelly, dried herbs, and juicy raspberries, leading to hints of pencil lead and baking spices. Medium to full-bodied, the palate delivers impressive brightness commingled with ripe, juicy black fruit flavors, supported by grainy tannins and bold freshness, finishing with a minty lift.”
