“The flagship J. Daniel Cuvée from Lail Vineyards is named after Robin Daniel Lail’s father – John Daniel Jr. – who made wine at Inglenook for more than 30 years. The 2017 vintage is sublime, with notes of smoky tobacco and wisps of lavender emerging from pools of inky blackberry. 930 cases were made from vineyards in Calistoga, Oakville and Stags Leap District and the silky tannins signal that this wine will only get better with age. The Lails enjoy J. Daniel with rack of lamb prepared by Robin’s son-in-law with fresh rosemary from Robin’s garden.”
